The Post-Secondary Scholarship has been created by the United Credit Union Board of Directors to help our members secure a brighter future through higher education. Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to applicants based on the criteria listed below.

Eligibility Requirement's:

- Student applicant must be a member and primary account holder in good standing with United Credit Union.
- Applicant must be a sophomore or higher enrolled in college in 2021 and under the age of 27.
- Applicant must have at least a college GPA of 3.0 during the year.
- Previous scholarship recipients of the United Credit Union are not eligible to apply.
- Proof of enrollment at an accredited institution; university, community college, trade school or vocational school.

Selection Criteria:

Scholarship recipients will be selected based on:

- Community involvement
- Essay

The following must be submitted with application:

- School Transcript
- Single page containing typed answers to essay question
