## UCU Opens Scholarship Fund

### Eligibility Requirements

- ❖ Student applicant must be a member and primary account holder in good standing with United Credit Union.
- ❖ Applicant must be enrolled as a sophomore or higher level in college in 2019 (or earlier) and under the age of 27.
- ❖ Applicant must have a minimum cumulative college GPA of 3.0
- ❖ Employees and volunteers of United Credit Union and their household family members are not eligible to apply.
- ❖ Proof of enrollment required as a full-time or part-time student at an accredited institution; university, community college, trade school or vocational school.

## EStatements: Easy On You and the Environment



Save yourself some clutter at the same time you save a tree: Sign up for eStatements. Receiving your account statement electronically is easy and secure. Each month, we'll send you an email alerting you that your account statement is available on line. Then you can simply log on to the credit union's website and take a look to make sure everything is in order. You can download your statement, plus previous statements are also stored on the site. That means no more shuffling through papers on the kitchen counter or your desk to check on a transaction from six weeks ago. Your statement is just a few clicks away. And if you spend an extended time away from home, there are no worries about changing your address. You'll have access anywhere you can go on line. Signing up for e-Statements is easy. Just contact the credit union and we'll show you how.

## Tis' The Season To Practice Debit Card Safety

You can still take advantage of all that your debit card offers while keeping your info and funds safe and secure. Simply follow our Debit Card Safety Tips for ultimate protection and security during the holidays, and all year round:

- \* Track every transaction so you don't overspend.
- \* NEVER share your Personal Identification Number (PIN) code, with anyone.
- \* Protect your PIN. Avoid writing it down, keeping it in your wallet, or saving it on a computer.
- \* Practice ATM safety. Always be alert and go with your gut.
- \* Monitor your account by checking frequently.
- \* Report to United Credit Union immediately if you think your car stolen.
