## Largest Snowman

In 2008 Bethel, Maine became the home of the world's tallest snowman according to the Guinness World Records. The snowman was named in honor of Olympia Snowe, a U.S. Senator representing the state of Maine.

Olympia measured 122'1" in height and 13 million pounds of snow were used to build her. She was only a few feet shorter than the Statue of Liberty. Olympia weighed 12,000,000 pounds, had two 5-foot wreaths for eyes, 16 snow skis for eyelashes, lips were made of 5 red car tires, chicken wire and painted cheesecloth made the 8-foot-long nose. Tow 30-foot-tall spruce trees were used for the arms, three 5-foot-wide truck tires made up the buttons. She also had a 130-foot scarf!
