## Share Secured Loans: Build Your Credit, Keep Your Savings

You've worked hard to build up your savings. You've been squirreling away funds for the down payment on a house or a new car or for taking a family vacation. So when life throws you a curve ball - your car needs a major overhaul or you break your leg - it's a shame to think you will need to raid your share savings account to pay for it. There is another way - and it doesn't involve putting unexpected expenses on a high-rate credit card or visiting a cash advance store or payday lender. Ask about a Share Secured Loan from the credit union. A Share Secured Loan uses your savings as collateral so it has a lower interest rate than a cash advance on a credit card or an unsecured personal loan. So you can take out the loan, pay it back, and leave your savings intact. A Share Secured Loan is also a good way to boost your credit score if you have a few blemishes on your credit record.
