The following books provide great opportunity to talk through the concepts as a family to gauge understanding:

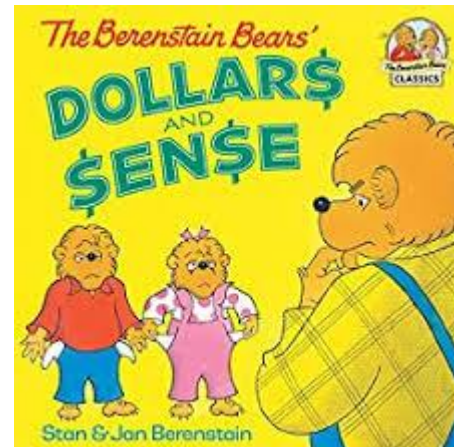
